Sample – Capítulo 1: THE END OF THE HUMAN ACTOR (1)

For decades, the human body was the central and irreplaceable element of visual desire. It was filmed endlessly, edited to alter it, and sold as a product. That was a fundamental constant. The Human is becoming unnecessary for the production of the image of desire. Visual generation tools powered by artificial intelligence no longer depend on actors standing in front of a camera, nor on film crews, nor on recording studios.

AI-generated pornography is not a future promise; it is an operational reality. And it works. Not because of— or not only because of— its growing technical quality, but because it fulfills, or promises to fulfill, exactly what the user wants to see. It does so without

the limits imposed by physical reality, without the need for negotiation with another person, without the fatigue or refusal of a human body, and without the awareness of interacting with another Human.

To understand the magnitude of this change, it is necessary to examine the previous situation. Before, to create any type of pornographic content, a human body had to perform. A real person had to physically expose themselves, move in a certain way, be recorded, repeat scenes, and sign contracts. There was a cost. A physical cost, often an emotional cost, and always, inevitably, a human cost. Even in its most industrialized and automated form, traditional pornography still required, as a basic element, a real body in front of the camera.
